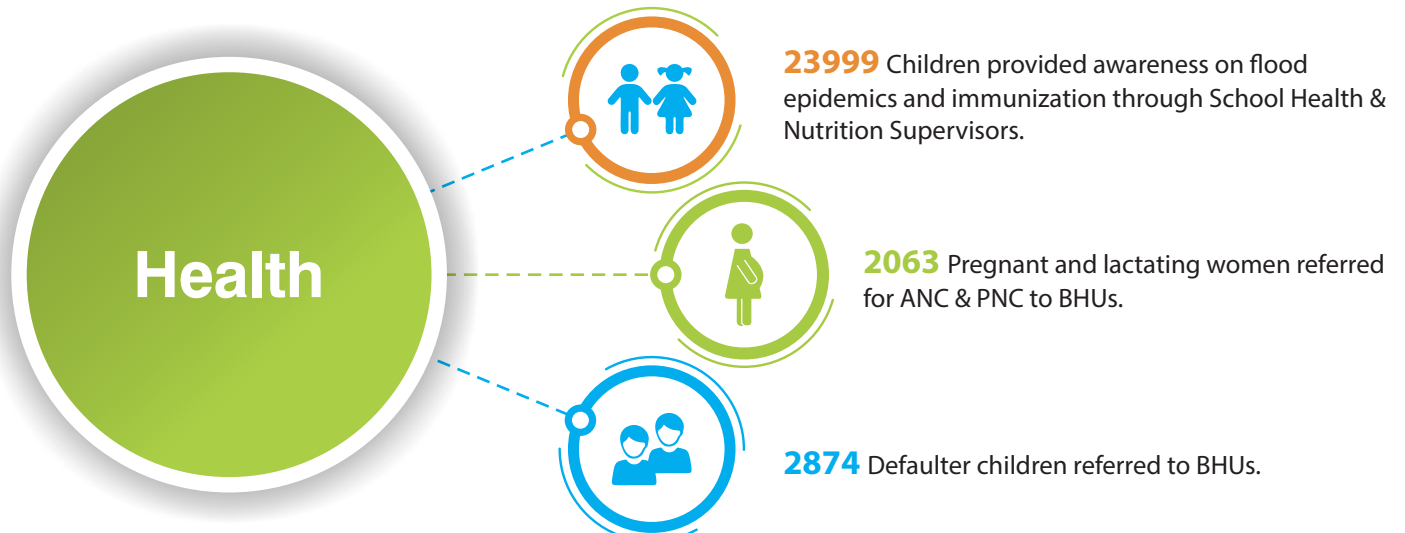
PROGRAM UPDATE

As of January 15, 2023

In response to devastating floods in July-August 2022, Sanjh Preet Organization responded swiftly to help the affected communities by provision of integrated services like child protection, health, education, WASH, distribution of food and non-food items, shelter and cash grants with financial & technical assistance of UNICEF, and others.

Services Overview
