
PROGRAM UPDATE As of July 31, 2023

Child Protection Emergency Response in DG Khan and Rajanpur Districts of Punjab












Strengthening of Learning and Protection of Children (SLPC)

Sanjh Preet Organization is implementing this project with the support of Solidar Suisse in four slum areas of Islamabad: Golra, Bari Imam, Pir Wadhai, and Khanna Pull with technical input of JICA, the project provides tailored education solutions and bridges learning gaps for children, especially girls, complementing existing non-formal education institutions besides protecting children from abuse and violence through linkages with govt and NGO support services.

- 3094 students (1457 girls, 1637 boys) of 14 schools and 16 non-formal centers were provided support in teaching and learning during reporting period.
- Orientation session on Child Protection and Basic Life Skills were facilitated for 1326 students (606 girls, 720 boys) and 24 teachers in six schools/ ALP center.
- Reconstruction of 03 child friendly toilets and renovation of 04 rooms in 03 schools in slum area of Islamabad.
- Mr. Abid Gill Deputy Chief Advisor JICA AQAL Program inaugurated ALP center at Faiz Education System Alipur for 30 Orphan Children of Baseera Trust in Islamabad.



ALP Middle Teach Project (JICA)

The project is being implementing in collaboration with the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) with the purpose; to provide second chance of education to the children who left their school after completing primary education due to any reason. Under the project, Allama Iqbal Open University registered 65 students with its distance learning programme, and would also certify them after conducting examination.
