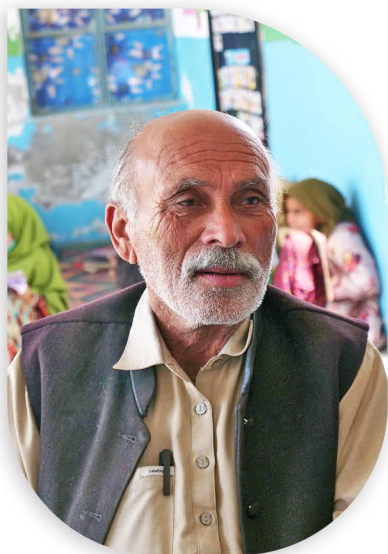

NEWLY ENROLLED OOSC RECIEVED BOOKS AND LEARNING KITS.

The Ministry of Federal Education and Professional Training, Government of Pakistan, partnered with Sanjh Preet as the Education Service Provider for the Enrolment, Retention and Progression of Out of School Children (OOSC). Under this project, Sanjh Preet has newly enrolled 544 children into ALP centers, private schools, Madrasas, Church and Public Schools in 6 UCs (UC-02, 09, 18, 19, 20, and 41) of the ICT area. Sanjh Preet received an award from the Secretary Ministry of Federal Education & Professional Training as acknowledgment in the Zero OOSC campaign in ICT. Additionally, Sanjh Preet participated and presented its best practices in the 7th International Conference on Research and Practices in Islamabad. Moreover, Sanjh Preet and Muslim Hands have agreed to collaborate in the ERP of OOSC in ICT.



CASE STUDY **MARCH 2024**

A GREAT CHAMPION FOR GIRLS EDUCATION

Mr. Muhammad Ashiq Hussain Birmani aged 64, is a retired Assistant Education Officer (AEO) born in village Imranabad Tehsil Kot Chutta of district DG Khan. He is currently involved in agriculture and social activities for the betterment of his village. He received his primary education from public school, which was a challenging experience because the school was 20 kilometers away from his home.

Field team met with him during establishment of Accelerated Learning Program Centers for Middle classes. During first meeting, he briefed the team that many girls were staying at home in his village Imranabad after completion of primary education. During visit of field officers, it was confirmed that due to non-availability of elementary schools, more than fifty girls were present in that area. After identification of girls according to set criteria of enrollment, two major concerns were faced by

field team. One was school space where all parents could agree to send their girls and second challenge was to mobilize parents in continuing their girls' educations. And Mr. Ashiq Hussain Birmani resolved the challenge by offering his home for ALP center and secondly he convinced parents by visiting door to door in continuing the education of their girls. Now he is also playing his role continuously for the follow-up of absent student of ALP centers and due to that all the students are regularly attending their class and completed sixth class successfully. Due to his strong role the center of ALP middle program is running successfully in safe environment.

According to him, establishment of ALP center was my dream and so I am working hard for success of ALP center at my village Imranabad. When the ALP Center was opened in my area, I thought that this would be the most important purpose of my life because our area is deprived and neglected due to various reasons.

Now, thanks to the grace and kindness of Allah, the girls come to study. I stay in touch with the parents of the girls, and the community and educate them. I hope that our future generations will not have to face any obstacles in getting an education.

I am grateful to the Sanjh Preet Organization & UNICEF. They opened this centre in my area, and I hope that we will continue our efforts to educate the girls.



OTHER PROJECTS MARCH 2024

WASH/CONSTRUCTION

Sanjh preet has provided clean drinking water to 300 households by installing 300 hand pumps in District Layyah with the generous support of Penny Appeal. In addition to that, one Mosque has been constructed in District Khanewal. With the support of Penny Appeal, a School building is also constructed that will benefit 205 students in District Jhang. While another mosque is under construction in tehsil shorkot district jhang.



IMPROVING LIVELIHOODS OF YOUTH BY IMPARTING SUSTAINABLE COMPUTER SKILLS

Muslim Charity is supporting Sanjh Preet Organization to empower the youth in District Nankana Sahib. Through this project, the organization has established an IT skills training center at Government Technical Training Centre More Khunda, district Nankana Sahib. This initiative aims to equip youth with vital computer skills, opening doors to better job prospects and improved livelihoods. Currently, more than 15 students has been enrolled and classes are set to be commenced by April 1st.



ALP MIDDLE TECH PROJECT

With the support of JICA, our ALP Middle Tech Centers are changing lives by helping students unlock their potential. We have two centers functional with 65 students in District Nankana Sahib. Currently, the students are progressing in semester 3. Beside the academic support, students are also being provided soft skills including art and craft and graphic designing skills. The centers will complete elementary cycle by July 2024. Students are passionate in continuing their education after completing this program. The project has cultivated a ray of hope among the students to learn, thrive and move forward.



MINOR REPAIR & MAINTENANCE MARCH 2024

Sanjh Preet, in collaboration with UNICEF and the School Education Department, South Punjab, is conducting minor repair and maintenance work in 200 flood-affected schools in DG Khan and Rajanpur. Out of these schools, 180 have already been completed, while work in 20 schools is in progress. Our emphasis is on infrastructure enhancement and provision of necessary facilities, with a dedicated focus on maintaining quality standards. To ensure this, our engineering and monitoring teams are actively present in the field.

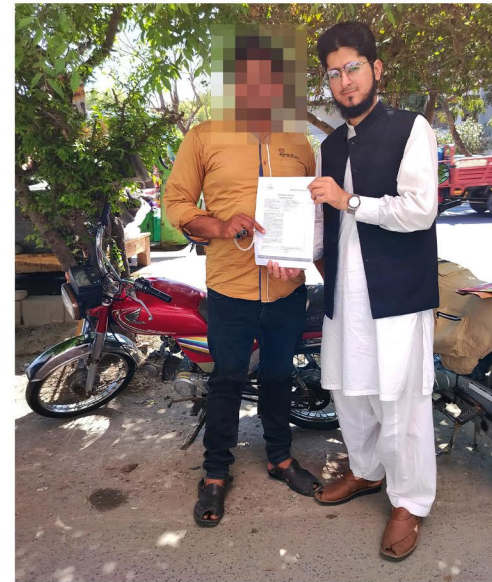
